## Castles



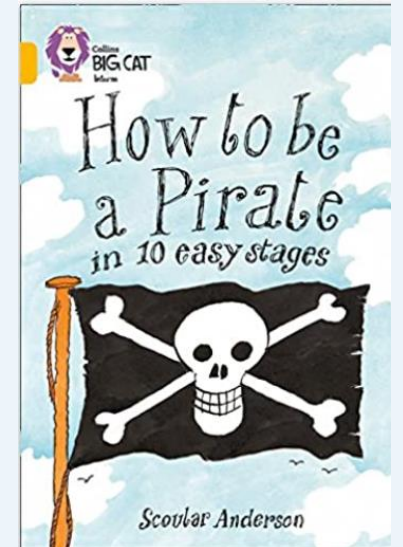
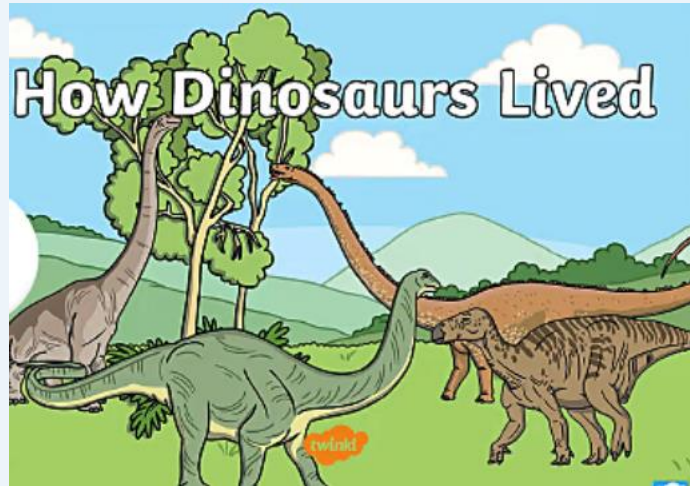
### Fun Facts!

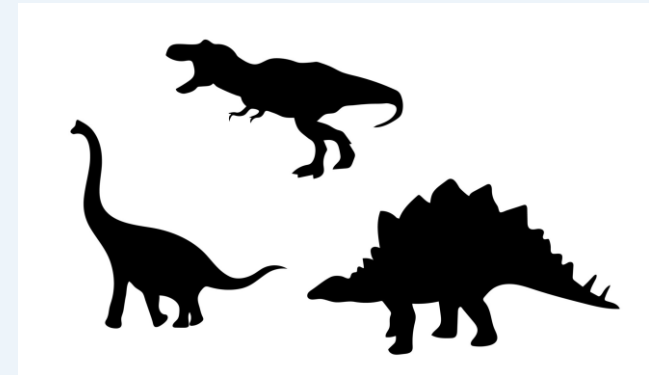
